

\* BTRFS => PB: Btrfs stores all links to an inode for a single directory in a fixed-size area. Consequently, the max number of hard links to a single file in a single directory is very limited: around 300 to 600, depending on the lengths of the file names.

This limit is not usually an issue, but it does cause problems for git, GNUS, GMame and BackupPC. [33]
